### Construction Line Now Online

Employers in the construction industry can now contact the WorkSafeBC **Construction Nurse Line** free of charge, and speak directly to a nurse advisor who is familiar with their industry.

The **Construction Nurse Line**, as a primary point of contact, can assist you in several areas:

- Return-to-work advice and assistance
- Injury management assistance
- Disability management program assistance
- Claim updates

Getting your workers back on the job is an important part of their recovery, and early intervention is the key to successful return-to-work planning. The longer an injured worker is off work, the more complex the issues and challenges become when trying to facilitate their return to work. Costs to employers can be significant.

The nurse advisors who answer your call will also be able to provide general claims update and clarify claim expectations. Nurse advisors can also come to your job site and meet with workers to facilitate return-to-work planning.
